


Reminder


The Hour of Code By: Anne Sabo

Each year since 2013, Code.org has sponsored an event called The Hour of Code. The Hour of Code started as a onehour introduction to computer science, designed to demystify "code," to show that anybody can learn the basics, and to broaden participation in the field of computer science. It has since become a worldwide effort to celebrate computer science, starting with 1hour coding activities.

Saint Pius At Tenth School. our kindergarten through fifth graders complete an hour of coding with the help of Code Monkey, an online resource. We start with simple block coding and move up to text coding.

What are the benefits, you might ask. There are many!

- Coding encourages creativity. Students have the opportunity to come up with their own solution.
- Coding boosts math skills. It is a very

- Coding teaches computational thinking. It teaches children to think critically.


