

# **Reflections from AIS**

As the AIS (Academic Intervention Services) teacher at St. Pius Tenth School, I get to work with students in kindergarten through fifth grade. Sometimes I pull small groups for focused work in my classroom, and other times I push in to support students in their classrooms. No matter what the setting, exciting things are happening at every grade level!

Kindergarten and first grade literacy groups are working hard to develop foundational reading skills. The students are mastering phonics patterns and applying those patterns as they read texts. We continue to practice breaking words apart into their individual sounds (segmenting) and putting sounds together to make words (blending). It is rewarding to watch the students grow in confidence as readers.


The second graders have made wonderful progress in their reading fluency, and are now focusing on answering higher-level questions about what they read. We recently read an article about the season of Lent, and the students highlighted details to support the main idea: "During Lent, we can do many things to prepare our hearts for Easter." In third and fourth grades, students have also been working on answering text-dependent questions by restating the question, answering the question with an inference, and using text details to support their response.

I have enjoyed pushing into the fifth grade classroom as students dive into morphology, or the study of the structure of words. We break words apart into their root words, prefixes, and suffixes and use the meanings of those individual parts to determine the meaning of the entire word. Studying morphology has helped the students to become more aware of language and to make meaning of unknown words they come across in their reading.

In math, our younger students are working to build number sense. They use cubes and counters to model addition and subtraction equations, and talk about "more than" and "less than." We also practice one-toone correspondence by pointing to only one object at a time as we count. In first grade and up, students are thinking critically with math word problems. They are learning to read, reread, and visualize what a problem is telling them. Then, they work to gather important information before deciding on a solution method. The fourth and fifth graders in particular are presented with multi-step word problems that challenge them to be critical readers and thinkers. We talk about reasonability, and whether a solution makes sense for a given problem.

As we approach the spring and start thinking about the end of the school year, I find myself so grateful for a wonderful first year teaching at St. Pius Tenth School. In addition to my daily interactions with students, I have loved getting to know the families; I look forward to each morning and afternoon that I have car line duty because of all the friendly faces I get to see!

Above all, going to Mass as a school community is the highlight of each month. Our Ash Wednesday Liturgy was a beautiful start to the Lenten season, and it was great to see so many school families and St. Pius Tenth parishioners worshiping together. To our parish family, Thank You for praying with and for our students. It means so much!
