The value of each donated item should be between \$10.00 and \$50.00. If we are blessed enough to be able to auction multiple baskets for any of our grade levels, that would be great, too! Please see the attached list which includes some item ideas.

If your family would like to donate an entire themed basket (see list), please let me know. Sponsors of all of our baskets will be acknowledged in our event program.

The deadline for sending in donations and/or completed baskets is Friday, April 19, so that we may assemble the baskets prior to our event on April 27th.

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Some Suggested Items for Themed Baskets

PreK 3 - Gardening Basket

Gardening gloves, potting soil, seeds, plant food, gardening tools (pruner, trowel, etc.), gift card to nursery, gardening hat, watering can, sprayer, fertilizer, (2) rolls of transparent cellophane (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

PreK 4 – Spa Basket

Nail files, bath bombs, meditation CD (or other relaxing music), hand and body lotion, spa gift card, loofah, body brush, scented candles, fancy soaps, facial masks, foot soak, bathrobe, slippers, manicure/pedicure kit, (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

Kindergarten - Movie Night Basket

Popcorn, popcorn containers, candy, movie tickets, gift cards, DVDs, hot chocolate, mugs, chocolate bars, (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

Grade 1 – Car Care Basket

Oil change gift card, car wash coupons, gas cards, car wash towels, car shampoo, wax, mini-vacuum, wash mitt, microfiber towels, floor mats, glass cleaning wipes, travel mug, tire cleaner and brush, a car wash bucket to fill (instead of a basket), (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

Grade 2 – Italian Food Basket

Gourmet pastas and sauces, dry cheeses, colander, spices, cheese grater, olive oil, balsamic vinegar, cans of anchovies, artichoke hearts, Italian breadsticks, Parmesan crackers, cruet set, Italian wine or sparkling champagne, wooden utensils, cappuccino, espresso and cups, dish towels (in the colors of the Italian flag), pasta platter, gift cards, (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

Grade 3 - Chocolate Basket

Fine chocolates, red wine, chocolate covered pretzels and/or nuts, gift cards, let your imagination go wild with this one! (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

Grade 4 – Summer Fun Basket

Beach towels, sunscreen, sunglasses, sun hats, bubbles, sand toys, beach toys, beach balls, flip-flops, insulated cups, Aloe Vera, insect repellent, outdoor games, gift cards, (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap basket

Grade 5 – Barbeque Basket

Grilling tools and utensils, BBQ sauces, spices/meat rubs, condiments, picnic basket, fabric napkins, grill starters, cutting board, spices, meat thermometer, spices, grilling mitts, summer sausage and crackers, table-top grill (to be used instead of a basket), (2) rolls of transparent cellophane wrap (or organza) and ribbon to wrap


- Wednesday, April 17th: Kindergarten, 1st grade, 2nd grade

- Pre-K families are welcome to visit on Tuesday, April 16th between 11:30-12:00




