Dear Families,

Beginning May 29, 2025, Saint Pius Tenth School will begin using an integrated version of the FACTS Tuition Management and FACTS SIS systems. This means that you will only need one log-in to have access to both portals (the tuition portal and the family portal).

As of May 29, you will access your FACTS account via FACTS Family Portal. You will find the Family Portal link on the school website or by following the steps below:

FACTS Family Portal Login Instructions

- Please go to the website https://www.factsmgt.com/
- Top Right on the site, click on "Log In Here" by Parents & School Administration
- In the "For K-12 Families" box click on "Family Portal Login"
- Enter the District Code (see below)
- If you already have an account, enter username and password, and click Login
- Click "Create New Account" if you have not set this up yet
- Enter the email address that received this email, and our District Code

Our District Code is **SPT-NY**

- You will receive an email from SIS Customer Support containing a link that will allow you
 to create your username and password. For security purposes the link will remain active
 for six hours.
- Please click on the link. A Change/Create Password screen will open. You may use the
 default username provided or create a new username. Then type in your desired
 password into the Password field and Confirm Field
- Click on the Save Username and/or Password button
- Close the window.
- Log into FACTS Family Portal as instructed above

Below is the bag policy that will be enforced for all events at Innovative Field. The following bag policies are aimed to ensure the safety and security of all fans.

- · Bags that do not meet the criteria will not be granted entry into the ballpark. Fans will be asked to return non-compliant bags to their vehicles.
- · Patrons without bags may access a designated expedited entry line.
- Fans are permitted one clear bag (not to exceed 16"x16"x8") and a non-clear bag that is 4.5" x 6.5" or smaller.
- The following bags are prohibited: backpacks, briefcases, non-transparent or oversized fanny packs, luggage, computer bags/cases, camera bags, and binocular bags.
- Exceptions apply to medical equipment/supply bags and diaper bags. Security will be present at all Innovative Field entrances to allow screening of these bags.
- · All bags are subject to security inspection upon entry and at any time within the stadium premises.
- · On-site storage facilities at Innovative Field are unavailable.
- · Patrons are advised to bring bags that facilitate easy inspection and remove bulky items, such as jackets and blankets, from bags during the inspection process.
- · Fans carrying bags that do not meet the criteria will not be granted entry into the ballpark
- Security reserves the right to deny entry to patrons with non-compliant bags or those who refuse inspection.

The following items are not permitted to be brought into Innovative Field: Firearms ·Illegal drugs and alcohol Knives Outside food or beverage ·Skateboards & rollerblades •Cans/bottles Beach balls and other inflatables ·Coolers ·Lawn chairs Unmanned aerial vehicles ·Sticks and clubs Nets ·Laser pointers Fireworks Toy guns

RED WINGS TRANSITION TO CASHLESS STARTING IN 2025

Tickets, Concessions, and Merchandise will be cashless at Innovative Field

ROCHESTER, NY – In an effort to enhance fan convenience and improve the overall experience at Innovative Field, the Rochester Red Wings are excited to announce that starting in 2025, the ballpark will transition to a **CASHLESS** environment. This will apply to all transactions, including concessions, merchandise, parking, food and beverage locations, and tickets.

This decision follows the lead of 29 of 30 Major League Baseball teams, including the Nationals at Nationals Park, and 26 of 30 Triple-A teams, which have already implemented cashless systems to streamline operations and improve the fan experience.

Fans can use all major credit and debit cards, including Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and American Express. Additionally, Apple Pay and Google Pay can also be used at concession stands and the team store. Fans who only have cash will be able to exchange it for Digital Diamond Dollars at the ticket office, which can be used throughout the ballpark for purchases.

To ensure smooth and efficient transactions, the Red Wings have added additional payment devices across the ballpark. The ticket office will accept card payments for all ticket purchases, including single-game tickets and season packages.

The cashless policy will take effect for the 2025 season. Cash will be accepted for purchases prior to March 3. For more information on this and all other ballpark policies, fans are encouraged to visit RedWingsBaseball.com or call the Red Wings Ticket Office at 585-454-1001.
