
We sent home hard copies of the forms last week. If you have not yet returned the form, please do so as soon as possible. Please let us know if you have any questions.

## Pre-K 3 News By: Holly Brennan

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself. My name is Holly Brennan and I am truly enjoying teaching in the Ptr-K3 program at St. Pius X school. My educational background includes both undergraduate and graduate degrees from Nazareth College in Education. Prior to becoming a teacher, I worked as a chemical dependency counselor at Park Ridge Hospital. It was there that I truly came to realize how critical the early years are in the development of a happy and productive life. I soon knew that teaching was what I wanted to pursue for the rest of my career.

After my experience at Park Ridge, I returned to school and earned an MS. Ed and permanent certification in Elementary Education. I am certified in grades Pre-K through 6. I must admit, this was one of the best decisions I have made throughout my life. I truly love teaching, especially the youngest of children. Their curiosity, eagerness and energy is so refreshing and often times contagious.

Our Pre-K3 class has had an amazing beginning to the school year. All of the children adapted so well to their first school experience and quickly settled into the routines and rules within our classroom. Each day, we continually reinforce the most fundamental of these rules such as being kind to each other, sharing and using language to express feelings and resolve challenges. I have seen growth in all of these areas. At this stage, social development is key and just playing together provides invaluable opportunities to develop these skills.

Each day, the children also have a period of time for just play. They can chose what they would like to play and with whom. There are many toys and games in our room that stimulate growth in the process of socialization.

The other aspect of our program is academic. Children have caught on quickly to many of the concepts we are working on. Each day, we begin with morning work, which may consist of puzzles or coloring to further develop fine motor skills. Then we move on to do our calendar, with which we focus on the month, days of the week and the weather. Next would be center time which consists of students rotating between different areas that focus on math, ELA, sensory, and creative or art centers. Our academic curriculum consists of name recognition, letter and number recognition, along with beginning sounds and number amounts. They also have time for PE, Art, and Music, which they love!

The most important is saved for last. Our program is completely faith based. Religion is a core part of our day. We begin and end each day with prayer. Faith and our principles are interwoven into every aspect of our time together. Whether this may be social interaction or struggles experienced, we look to God for His guidance and support. Christmastime is a wonderful opportunity to teach about God, Jesus and the concept of unconditional love.
