SWEM wants to thank you, the students, and everyone at St. Pius Tenth School for the fabulous donation of cereal. SWEM and other emergency food cupboards are always in need of breakfast cereal since it is so desirable for families. Your 532 boxes of cereal collected for Catholic Schools Week weighed in at 537.5 pounds!

After the boxes of cereal had served their purpose as education aids and "dominos" at your school, they will now join other food items to fill our emergency food bags. With the rising cost of food and inflation in general, SWEM has seen an increase in requests for emergency food. In January 2022, we gave out 100 emergency grocery bags but by the end of the year the number distributed per month had doubled. As food insecurity in our community continues, we thank the St. Pius X School community for helping our neighbors in need.

We also want to thank John Falk for delivering all those cartons and bags filled with the cereal boxes; it was quite a task to do on his own.


