Dear St. Pius Tenth School Families,

We were made aware late last week of a calendar change to the Gates-Chili Central School District calendar. As we rely on school bus transportation from the district, we must follow the same changes to our calendar. I apologize in advance for any inconvenience that this may cause, but I wanted to provide as much advance notice as possible.

Please make note of the following:

Thursday, May 23, will be added to the Memorial Day weekend. Days off will now be Thursday, May 23 through Monday, May 27. School will reopen on Tuesday, May 28.

The last day of school will now be Friday, June 21, instead of Tuesday, June 25. Friday, June 21 will be a $\frac{1}{2}$ day of school.

This means that the date of 5^{th} Grade commencement will now be Friday, June 21, at 2:00 PM.

The last day for Pre-K 3 will remain Thursday, June 20, and the last day for Pre-K 4 will remain Friday, June 21.

For those families who utilize our after-school care program, there will be no after care on Friday, June 21, as it will be a $\frac{1}{2}$ day.

As we understand it, the change was made because the district did not have any emergency closures this year. According to the notification, in the event of an emergency closing between now and then, the schedule may be adjusted again.

Again, I sincerely apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause. Please let me know if you have any questions at all.
