1st Grade News

We are getting ready to enter the last quarter of the school year. It's safe to say that everyone is getting excited, and many of the students are already sharing some of their plans and ideas for the summer vacation, even though it is barely Spring. While that summer break can almost be seen on the horizon, there's still plenty of work to tackle



here in the first grade classroom!

In Phonics / Reading our independent reading skills have really started to progress very nicely. We have been working very hard at reading comprehension with a particular focus on pulling context from multiple sources to make comprehension easier.

In Math we are getting ready to wrap up our unit on Adding and Subtracting numbers from 1-120. Next, we are going to be learning the importance of, and how to, measure different types of things accurately

using different types of tools and units.

In Science, we are just wrapping up a unit on the Sun, Moon, stars, and all of the other things we can learn about just from looking at the sky. Our next unit will be focused on how animals and plants make adaptations to make survival easier.

In Social Studies we still have a little ways to go before we finish our unit focused on communities. Our next unit will focus on local economics. We will be learning how people and communities depend on and change their environment in order to better meet their needs.

In Religion we are continuing to discover not just how Jesus wants us to treat people but why he wants us to treat people with love and kindness. While this is definitely an important topic for us to cover, this group of first graders already has a very good grasp on how they should be treating others whether it be one of their close friends or someone brand new.

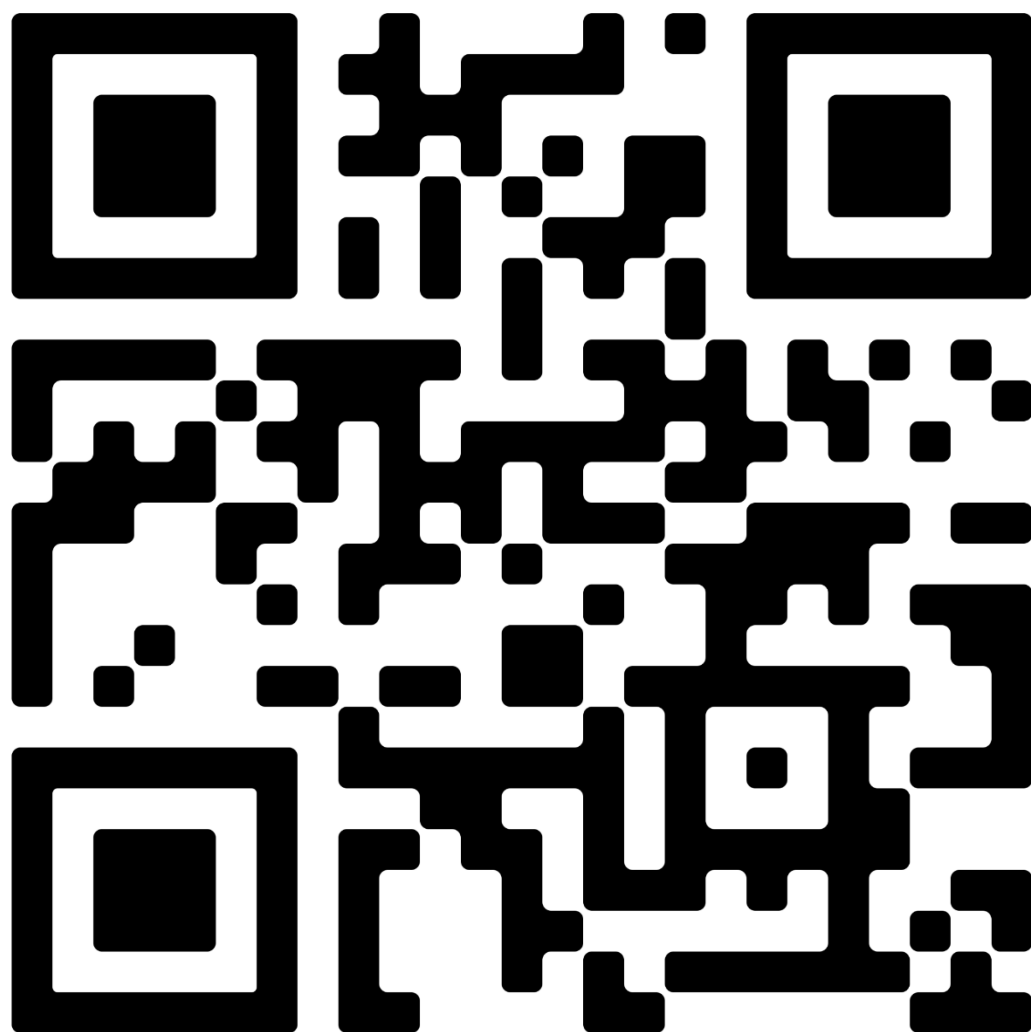

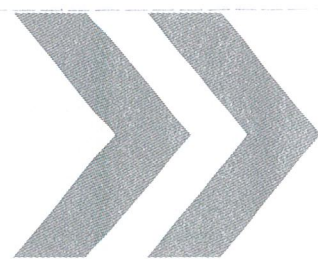

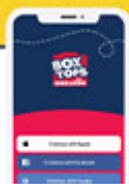

INGREDIENTS

- 1 can (13 oz) refrigerated Pillsbury™ Flaky Cinnamon Rolls with Butter Cream Icing (8 Count)
- 8 semisweet chocolate chips
- 4 red baking chips or candy-coated chocolate candies
- 8 almond slices

DIRECTIONS

- 1 Heat oven to 350°F. Spray cookie sheet with cooking spray.
- 2 Place 4 rolls on cookie sheet, about 3 inches apart. Unwind remaining 4 rolls into long dough strips. For each bunny, place one dough strip, cut ends together, next to a whole roll. Press and firmly pinch cut ends into top of whole roll. Shape strip into floppy bunny ears.
- 3 Bake 12 to 15 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 5 minutes before removing to cooling rack.
- 4 Spread frosting on warm rolls. On each bunny, place two chocolate chips for eyes, 1 red baking chip for nose and 2 almond slices for teeth. Serve warm.
