Keeping Our Children Safe By: Anne Sabo

Our children have the world at their fingertips and may carry it in their pocket with access to the Internet from a variety of devices. While that access offers the for education them opportunity and entertainment, it also comes with many risks to both their physical and emotional well-being. Therefore, it is our role as parents/guardians and teachers to be sure our children are safe and well prepared as they launch their voyage around the world. We need to travel with them and keep informed of their encounters along the way.

Children are using the internet for a variety of reasons. We need to stay current on their activities and be sure to give them guidance on their usage.

Communicating and social networking: Online communication is constantly changing. It seems there are new platforms on an almost daily basis. Children may be using these platforms to share gossip, exchange photos, make weekend plans, find out about missed assignments, connect over common interests, and share their opinions. The downside is they may become a target of strangers, predators, and cyber bullies. It is important that their trusted adults know who they are communicating with online. Ask your child if he/she really knows his/her online friends and have him/her remove anyone whom he/she has not met in person. We also need to remind them not to share personal information like a phone number, address or photos.

Web surfing: Children can explore new interests,

check to see if a library book is available, or find a new recipe they would like you to make in the many valuable resources found online. However, surfing without guidance may open them up to pop-up ads, viruses, and inappropriate content.

How many of you have been amazed at how much time can be lost in our travels online? It is also important to limit the amount of screen time your child has each day.

Gaming: Children are able to find a wide variety of games on the internet. Although many may provide educational enrichment or reinforcement, video games may limit a child's social interactions and displace other interests. Some gaming sites offer chat rooms and expose children to the hazards of giving away personal information to a "friend" who shares their common interest. So, again, it is important to be aware of the gaming sites your child is visiting.
