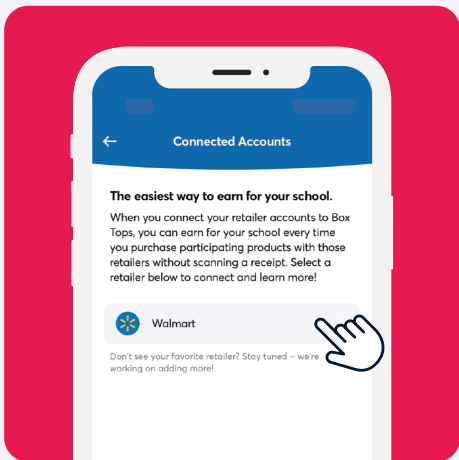

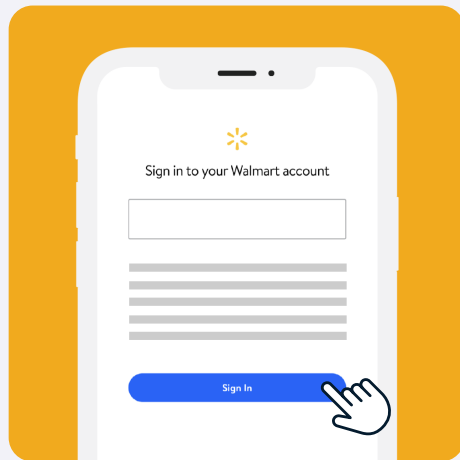

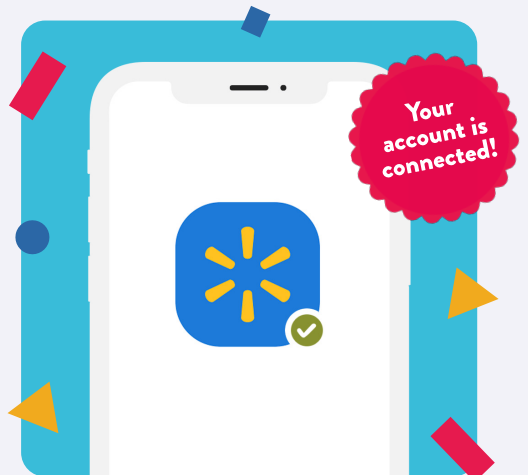
### STEP 1
