Students are not required to wear school uniforms on this day; however, they must <u>**DRESS UP**</u> for pictures. Make up day for students who are not present on October 13 is scheduled for Friday, December 2.

Our next school liturgy is Friday, October 14 at 9:30 AM. Families are welcome to join us, and we ask that all students dress in their school uniform for all liturgies, even if it is a PE day for them.

Our Optional Lunch Program is scheduled to begin on Monday, October 17. Please note that orders may no longer be accepted for the 1st semester.

The 2nd semester begins in January, at which time the ordering process will begin again.

Please note that November 10, 2022 is a scheduled ½ day for students. Dismissal is at 11:45 AM. We will communicate information regarding those districts who will be providing bus service at dismissal on that day as soon as we have contacted all districts.

If you know of anyone who may be interested in filling an upcoming vacancy in our After Care program, please ask them to reach out to me. It is Monday through Friday from 3:30 PM to approximately 5:30 PM. This is a paid position – not volunteer.





SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

AT ST. PIUS X CHURCH 2022-2023

GENERAL SACRAMENTAL READINESS CRITERIA



Primary criteria for sacramental preparation is to **celebrate Mass weekly** at St. Pius X. Secondly, that this is **at least the second, consecutive year** that you are enrolled in a Catholic School or a Parish Faith Formation/Youth Ministry Program.

SPECIFIC SACRAMENTAL READINESS CRITERIA



First Reconciliation—Baptized Roman-Catholic, at least 7 years old, able to understand he/she can sin, have desire to be forgiven and ability to ask for it.

First Eucharist—Baptized Roman-Catholic, who is at least 7 years old, and has prepared and celebrated First Reconciliation, knows the Eucharist is Jesus and wants to be one with Jesus and Church by receiving Communion.



Confirmation—Baptized Roman–Catholic who is at least in 8th grade, and have celebrated First Eucharist and First Reconciliation and have a desire for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, received in Baptism, to be strengthened to help him/her live a Holy life, can register for the 1st of 2 years of Confirmation

Prerequisite Process. After that is registration for the Immediate Preparation Program.
