

Greetings Saint Pius Tenth School Families!

Well, we knew it was coming! The weather is turning, and we must be sure that our students are both safe and comfortable. Please review the memo included this week that provides information about uniforms and school closings for inclement weather. Also, please know that if a student is not appropriately dressed for the weather conditions, they may be asked to remain indoors (supervised) during PE and/or recess times.

Our next school liturgy is Tuesday, November 1, 2022 – All Saint's Day. All students should be in full uniform, even if they have PE.

Please note that November 10, 2022 is a scheduled ½ day for students. Dismissal is at **11:45 AM**. Following is the information that we have regarding end of day dismissal transportation:

Brockport - Will transport on all of our scheduled ½ days

Churchville Chili - Will NOT transport on any of our scheduled ½ days

Gates Chili - Will transport on ONE of our ½ days (this will be on November 10)

Greece (Ontario Transportation) - TBD We have not heard back from them

Hilton – Will transport on all of our scheduled ½ days

Spencerport - Will transport on all of our scheduled ½ days

Wheatland Chili - Will NOT transport on any of our scheduled ½ days

St. Pius Tenth School $\frac{1}{2}$ days this school year are November 10, 2022; December 22, 2022; February 17, 2023; March 17, 2023.

November 10 is also our scheduled pick up day for fundraiser items. Pick up will be from 12:00 PM-3:00 PM, using the same carline format as is used for arrival and dismissal. Please pull through the carline down to the North end of the school building where volunteers will be waiting to load items into cars. If you know that you will be unable to come during the designated pick-up times, please let the office know, and we can make alternate arrangements.

November 11 is a scheduled day off as we recognize and remember our Veterans.

Please see the PAC information included this week. The Halloween flyer explains our celebration to take place on Monday, October 31, and there is a follow-up letter with information about volunteering and after-school clubs.

Any classroom celebrations for Halloween will be directly communicated by your child's classroom teacher. Just a reminder that any treats sent to school MUST BE STORE BOUGHT AND INDIVIDUALLY WRAPPED BY THE VENDOR. Treats that come in unwrapped will be held until the end of the school day and sent home with your child. Thank you for your cooperation!

Re: Weather Reminders

I thought now would be a good time to remind everyone of the following:

- <u>Recess/PE:</u> Students often go outside during the school day for recess and need to wear appropriate clothing for the weather conditions. This includes hats, gloves/mittens and boots when necessary. A reminder that uniform shorts are not allowed after November 1st. On days when PE classes are scheduled, students are expected to wear the full PE uniform. This includes tee shirt, shorts with sweatshirt and sweatpants worn over them. Students may take off their "sweats" during PE if they so desire.
- Weather emergency closings: If school will be closed due to inclement weather or other uncontrollable conditions, information will be available over local radio and television stations from 7:00 AM on. We follow the Gates-Chili School District (if Gates Chili is closed due to weather, we are closed) but also consider other district information. Saint Pius Tenth School will send a text message via FACTS to all families regarding closures.

We request that parents/guardians do not call to ask if the school is closed or is closing. During a time of inclement weather, school personnel responsible for conducting the school closing procedures are extremely busy. A text message will be sent to families as soon as we are notified that the school will be closed or closing.
