Social Emotional Learning

Children come to school to learn Math, Reading, Science and much more. They use their brain to absorb new material in all their subjects. Social emotional learning is just as important. 5th graders start their mornings with a meeting. Each week introduces a new topic from dealing with conflicts to preparing for tests. I love hearing the dialogue between the children and their insights. They realize it is a safe place to share if they want to, and ok to pass if they don't want to share. Meetings are started by posing a question they all can answer if they choose- questions can be serious or silly. We have discussed questions like "What type of learner do you think you are?" to "If you had a dragon what would you name it?" The question starts the conversation, which makes the children comfortable. The activity or focus of the meeting then asks partners to discuss topics or scenarios. During this time, they are practicing social skills such as being a good listener. They practice eye contact, questioning, paying attention and active listening. At the end of the meeting we will often share our discussions and it is remarkable to hear their comments. The children have come up with possible solutions to conflicts that may arise as well as advice for others. The purpose is to reach out to students in a way other than academics. Knowing how to read and write is necessary, but it is also important to navigate the everyday situations they will experience. The children really seem to enjoy this time and some of the comments I hear are very mature. The goal of these meetings is to help the children integrate the skills they learn and their usefulness in their days. We will often refer to a meeting when dealing with a problem. Students also get to spotlight themselves by sharing things about their lives and their families. Each child is celebrated and it is interesting to discuss the things we didn't know about the spotlight person!



SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION Sacramental

AT ST. PIUS X CHURCH Spring 2022

GENERAL SACRAMENTAL READINESS CRITERIA

Primary criteria for sacramental preparation is to **celebrate Mass weekly** at St. Pius X. Secondly, that this is **at least the second, consecutive year** that you are enrolled in a Catholic School or a Parish Faith Formation/Youth Ministry Program .

SPECIFIC SACRAMENTAL READINESS CRITERIA

First Reconciliation—Baptized Roman-Catholic, at least 7 years old, able to understand he/she can sin, have desire to be forgiven and ability to ask for it.

First Eucharist—Baptized Roman-Catholic, who is at least 7 years old, and has prepared and celebrated First Reconciliation, knows the Eucharist is Jesus and wants to be one with Jesus and Church by receiving Communion.

This is not a registration but you'll definitely be on the list as soon as we get enough players and coaches to field a few teams.


