As of right now, the tests will be the full implementation of multiple choice, short answer, and extended response. Last year, as you recall, the tests consisted of only multiple choice questions. Students have begun preparation in their classes.

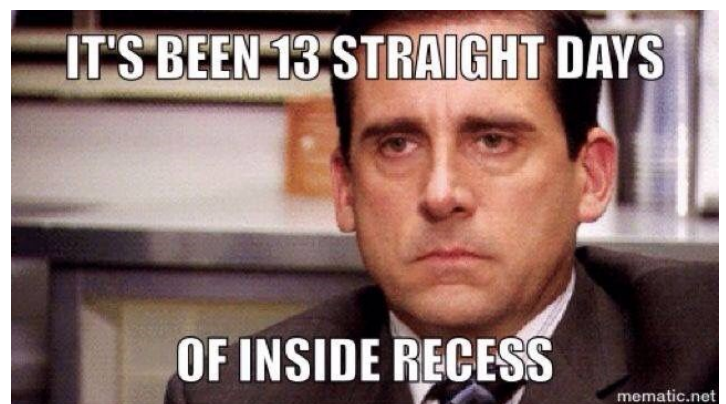
