Greetings Saint Pius Tenth School Families

On behalf of the faculty and staff of our school, I would like to thank the Kindergarten and 1st Grade families for providing a wonderful lunch for us this past Friday. It was most definitely enjoyed by all!

Registration for the 2022-2023 School Year is now open. Registration forms were sent home with students, or they may be found on our website. Classes are filling up. A completed registration form and fee will secure a student's registration.

If any current family refers a family new to our school, both families receive a tuition credit!

New York State ELA testing for Grades 3 – 5 is scheduled to be administered between March 29 and March 31. As of right now, the tests will be the full implementation of multiple choice, short answer, and extended response. Last year, as you recall, the tests consisted of only multiple choice questions. Students have begun preparation in their classes.

Though our April school liturgy will remain open to students only, I am hopeful that, very soon, we will be able to extend the invitation to any families wishing to join us. In the meantime, school liturgies will be livestreamed for the remainder of the school year. Please log onto:

Friday, April 8, 2022, is our Spring Superintendent's Conference Day. There is no school for students.

I can't believe that the school year is already nearing the homestretch. 3rd Quarter Report Cards are scheduled to be sent out on Thursday, April 14, 2022.

The school will be closed on Good Friday, April 15. Spring Recess is Monday, April 18 – Friday, April 22. School will reopen on Monday, April 25.

NYS Math Assessments will be administered beginning on Tuesday, April 26, 2022, for students in Grades 3 – 5.

Music Moments

Here is a sampling of recent Music class activities. As you can see, we've been very busy!

PreK

PreK children have been responding to loud and quiet music and creating their own patterns of loud and quiet. They especially enjoyed listening to Haydn's "Surprise Symphony" and reacting to the loud "wake-up" surprises in the piece. They also have enjoyed giving directions to "La-La" the lamb, or "Melody" the monkey, their class puppets, using their singing voice.

Kindergarten

Kindergarten children love to sing directions to their class puppet, "Mr. Moosic," the cow. They did the "Wallaby Hop," learned a kangaroo song, and moved to "Kangaroos" from *Carnival of the Animals*.

1st Grade

1st grade students have enjoyed playing "Mr. Potato Head," a voice-guessing game. They are learning to read simple melodies using *solfa*. They sang "sea" songs: "Haul Away Joe", "Wishy Washy Wee" and "When I was One."

2nd Grade

2nd grade students learned about Impressionism in art and music. They created drawings inspired by Claude Debussy's composition, "Clair de lune" ("Moonlight"). They continue to practice reading and performing rhythm patterns with quarter notes, eighth notes, quarter rests and half notes.

3rd Grade

3rd grade students have been practicing reading and performing rhythm patterns with sixteenth notes. They played a stick game with "E Papa," a song from the Maori people of New Zealand. As they learned about the 3/4 time signature they really enjoyed "An Austrian Went Yodeling"!

4th Grade

4th grade students have been working hard at reading staff notation and playing melodies on xylophones, metallophones, and glockenspiels. They have learned to read and perform rhythm patterns with eighth note-sixteenth note combinations.

5th Grade

5th grade students have just wrapped up six lessons on jazz, ranging from Dixieland to swing. They really enjoyed singing and playing "Scoo Be Doo," a fun scat singing song (not about the famous cartoon dog!)

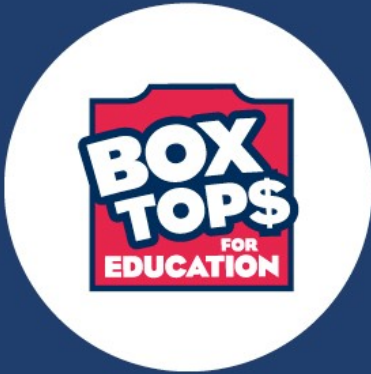

Conditions

- Applications must be submitted to the Board of Education by Gates Chili residents prior to April 1 per The New York State Education Department Regulation of the year in which transportation is needed in September. New residents to the District have until August 1 to file an application.
- Transportation to/from locations other than the legal residence (i.e. babysitters) must be within the same attendance area as the school legally attended. Per Board of Education policy, written requests for such service must be filed annually in the Transportation Office by July 1 preceding each school year. Alternate location transportation must be on a five-day-per-week basis for the entire school year.
- Transportation will not be provided to private/charter schools when GCCSD is not in session.
- Early dismissals for private/charter schools will be limited to the same number of early dismissals as noted on the Gates Chili school calendar.
